- **Subsidised Apartment**
Fully furnished, fully equipped and ready for occupation.
- **8 Hours Consulting and Advisory Sessions**
 - i. Legal support package: 2 sessions with a legal professional to assist with company set-up.
 - ii. Taxation package: 2 sessions with a tax advisor to assist with setting up an appropriate tax structure.
 - iii. Accountancy: 2 sessions with an accounting expert to assist with business registration and accountancy practices.
 - iv. HR and Employment: 2 sessions with a HR expert to assist with HR and employment related matters.

MENTORING AND ADVISER SUPPORT

The *Kerry Business Welcome Pack* will provide you with a 'Business Buddy' or general mentor to advise on local and European business. This experienced business practitioner has both international and local experience, knowledge, skills, insights and entrepreneurial capability to provide you with business knowledge and protocol advice. This person can contribute independent advice to aid your decision making. The partner group will facilitate introduction to the local business circle to build your social networks.
